# Day one

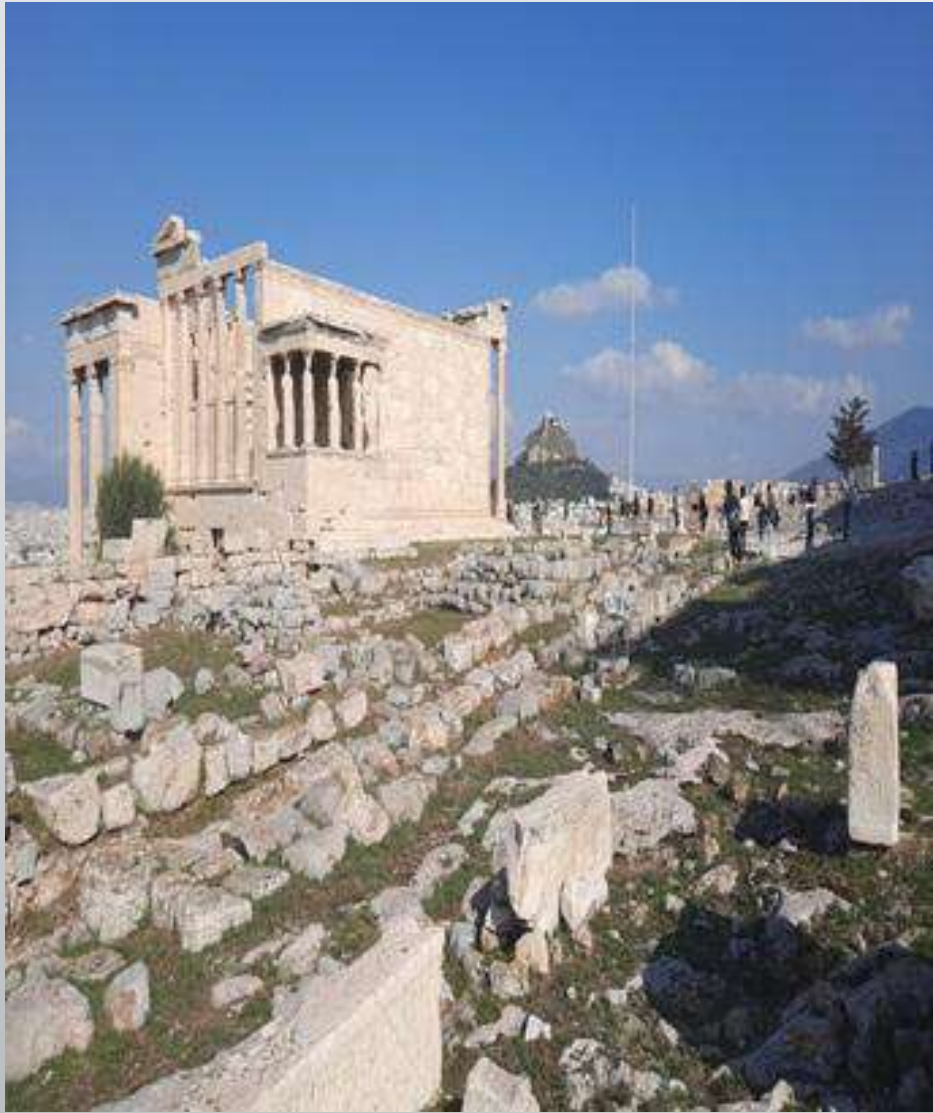
1. We woke up then we got ready to leave.

# Day three

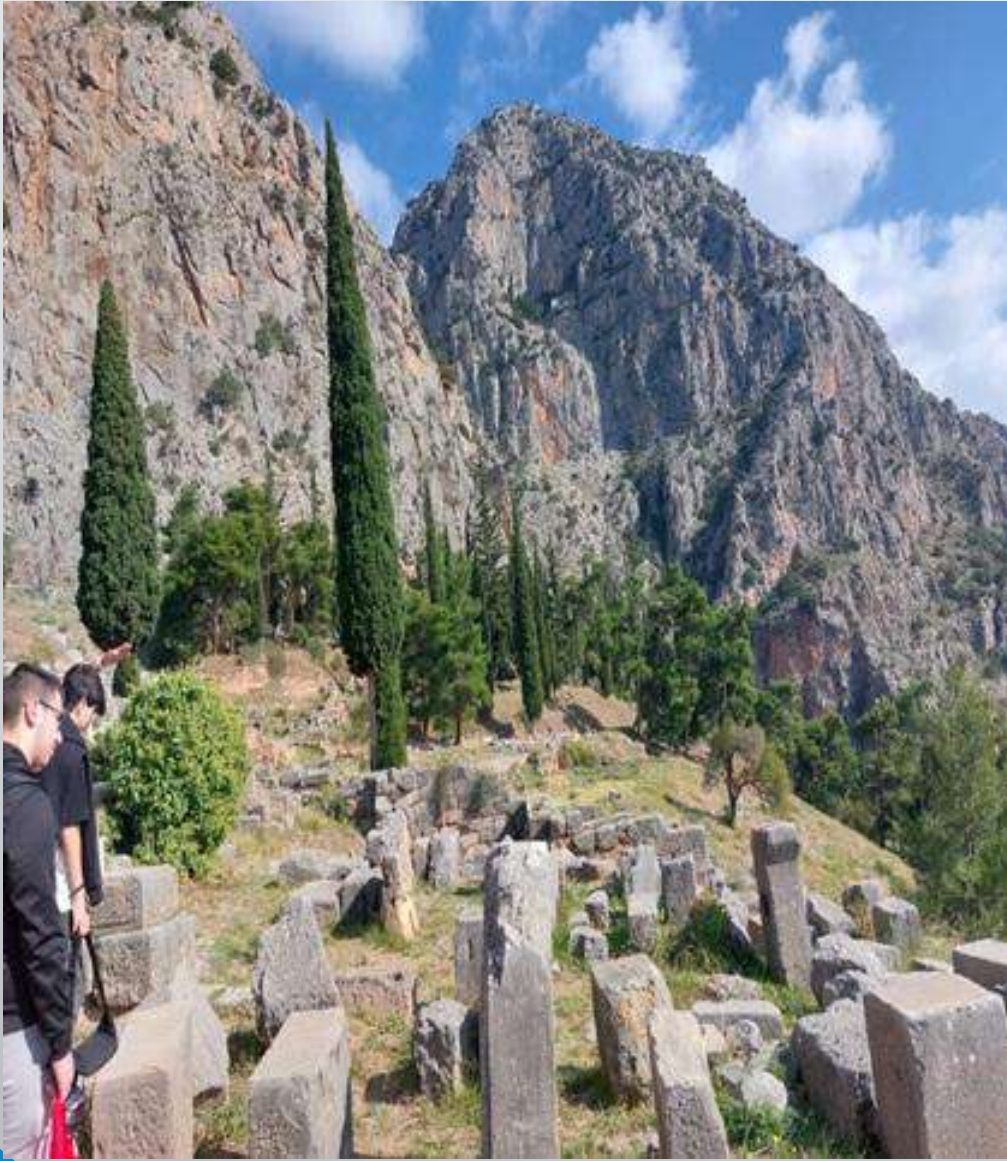
1. After the daily routine, we went to school, where we carried out many fun and beautiful mathematical activities, but also sports activities plus other ice-breaking activities.
